Subject : SEARCH FOR THE DIVISION OF TANGUB'S MOVING UP SPEECH FOR PUBLIC and PRIVATE HIGH SCHOOLS

Date : April 5, 2016

1. To give due credit and recognition to the effort done by the Grade 10 First Honors in this division, a search for best moving-up speech will be conducted this April 19, 2016 @ 9:00 a.m. at the Division office.
2. This activity is in its 5th year of implementation initiated and sponsored by the Local Government Unit of Tangub City, under the leadership Hon. Mayor Phillip T. Tan, Vice Mayor Edemar S. Alota and the City Council Members, in cooperation with DepEd, Division of Tangub under the leadership of Dr. Victoria V. Gazo, Schools Division Superintendent.
3. All Grade 10 First Honors of Tangub City both in public and private are qualified to join in this contest.
4. The first five winners will compete for the Division Level Search, the schedule of which is to be determined later.
5. The moving-up speeches should be based on this year's graduation theme "Kabataang Mula sa K to 12, Tagapagdala ng Kaunlaran sa Bansang Pilipinas" with the following criteria:

Masterpiece Relevant to the Theme:	20%
Organization of Speech (content, sentence structure)	20%
Voice (quality, dynamics, articulation, pronunciation)	20%
Power of Expression (emphasis)	20%
Stage Presence (personal appearance, poise & confidence)	10%
General Effect (interesting, convincing, holds attention)	<u>10%</u>

6. The time limit for delivery should be a minimum of three (3) minutes and a maximum of five (5) minutes only. A one point deduction shall be given for every minute excess of time.
7. All Division Level Qualifiers shall submit hard copies of their pieces to be placed in long folders at the Division Office on or before the conduct of the Division Contest.
