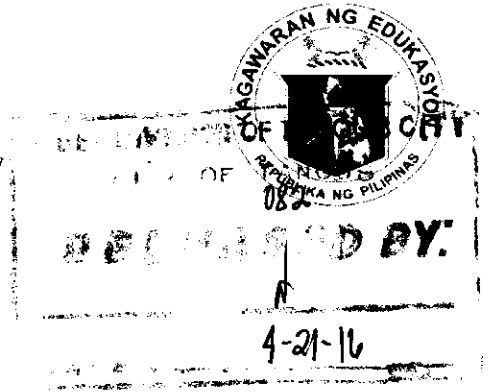

Subject: Contextualizing the Curriculum for Kindergarten and Grade 1 Phase 1

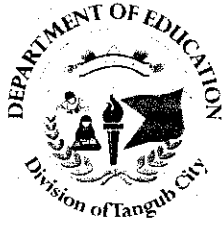
