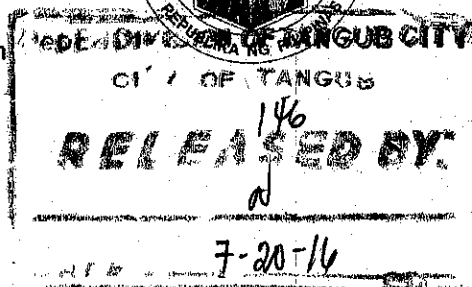

SUBJECT: **Division Training of Multigrade Teachers on Differentiated Instruction,
Literacy and Numeracy Skills Development**

1. The Department of Education through the Bureau of Elementary Education is strengthening the implementation of Multigrade Program in the Philippines. It has been proven that multigrade classes given appropriate interventions, and their teachers provided with materials and appropriate training on effective teaching approaches can perform well in accordance to standards.
2. With this, the Division will conduct 3 day training for Multigrade Teachers on Differentiated Instruction, Literacy and Numeracy Skills on July 27, 28 & 29, 2016 at Bethany Garden's Ozamiz City.
3. The Division Training aims to:
 - a. To enhance knowledge, skills and attitude in teaching MG classes as of language and cognitive development;
 - b. To improve ability in gauging pupil's learning outcomes in MG class through the use of appropriate assessment strategies; and
 - c. To develop an instructional material that enhance the reading skills of the learners.
4. The training costs, which cover meals and snacks, lodging, supplies and materials, trainer's fee shall be charged to MG Funds. While travelling expenses of participants will be charged to school funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
5. Participants are the Multigrade teachers. They are requested to bring Curriculum Guide during the training. **Cluster heads/ school Administrators of the multigrade schools are requested to join the training on the third day.**
