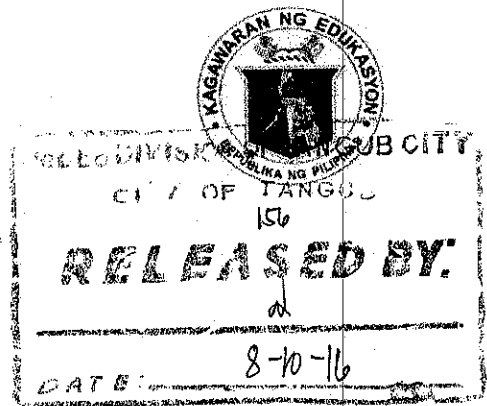

Subject: **Chief Girl Scout Medal Scheme (CGSMS) Seminar-Workshop**

Date: **August 10, 2016**

1. A council-wide Chief Girl Scout Medal Scheme (CGSMS) Seminar-Workshop (live-out) will be conducted to provide opportunities to senior girl scouts (high school) who are willing and interested to work out certain projects and at the same time serve our people in the community.
2. This is scheduled on August 13-14 (Saturday and Sunday) for the Second Congressional District of Misamis Occidental. The venue is at Ozamiz City National High School
3. Participants:
 - a. Registered Senior Girl Scouts of their respective schools for this fiscal year;
 - b. Should have at least three years of Girl Scouting experience as Junior and Senior Scouts;
 - c. Must have earned at least two (2) badges in each of the 8-point challenge in the senior level before the start of the scheme;
 - d. Must be endorsed by their principals, troop leaders and parents;
 - e. Determined to take up the challenge of extending service with the help of the community people to improve themselves and transform the community into a conducive place to live in;
 - f. Preferably second year to senior high girl scouts.
4. Delegates of every school must be chaperoned with at least one (1) Troop Leader as project adviser.
5. Registration Fee of P150.00 shall be charged to MOOE/School Funds to cover the training materials, handouts, certificates and other administrative expenses subject to accounting and auditing rules and procedures. Travelling expenses must be shouldered by the participants.
6. Participants shall report to the training venue on August 13, 2016 at 7 o'clock in the morning in whole dress uniform and bring the following:
 - a. Writing materials
 - b. Packed lunch and snacks
