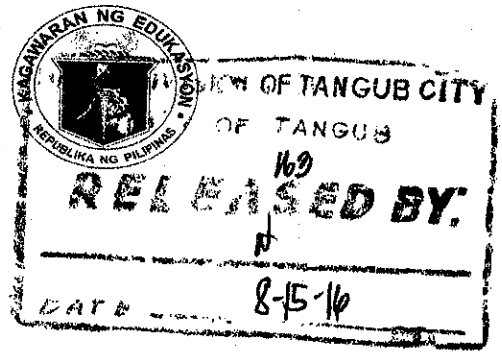

CONTEST LIMITS

- A maximum of two entries per participant
- Two-time winners of previous ABKD can no longer join
- Posters that have won or have been submitted in other contests won't be accepted
