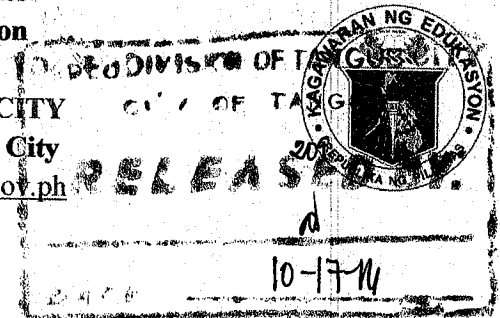

Subject: **Contextualizing the Curriculum for Kindergarten to Grade 3 (Phase 2)**

1. Pursuant to Republic Act No. 10533, Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013, as stipulated in its Implementing Rules and Regulations (Sec. 4 & 8) mandates DepEd to develop a curriculum that is culture-sensitive, contextualized and flexible enough to enable and allow the schools to localize, indigenize and enhance based on the specific educational and social context of communities, Division of Tangub City will conduct a Division Write shop on Contextualizing the Curriculum for Kindergarten to Grade 3 on October 25 - 26, 2016 at Alona Dreamland, Jimenez Misamis Occidental.
2. At the end of the this writeshop, participants are expected to develop a holistic perspective on the overall learning and socio-cultural context of indigenous communities specifically, participants are expected to:
 - a. Contextualize competencies for Kindergarten and Grade 1 to Grade 3 responsive to the Indigenous community being served,
 - b. Contextualized lesson plan for Kindergarten, Grade 1 to Grade 3 for IPed.
