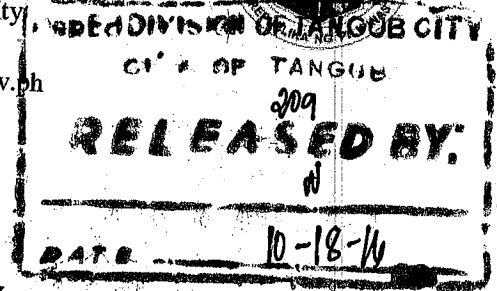




Subject: 2016 GSP Division-Wide Encampment

Date: October 18, 2016

1. The Division of Tanguib City will hold the 2016 GSP Division-Wide Encampment on **October 24-25, 2016 at Taguite Scouting Site, Taguite, Tanguib City.**
2. The objectives of the encampment are the following:
 - a. To prepare a scout to be instrument for peace and development in the community;
 - b. To prepare scouts in performing services in the community;
 - c. To improve leadership skills needed in the community;
 - d. To practice daily good turns to instill a sense of social responsibility among scouts.
3. Participants are Junior GSP and Senior GSP Scouts. A minimum of one (1) patrol or eight (8) girls per Troop Leader per district/secondary school. No limit as to the number of participants per district/secondary school provided the ratio of 1:4 for Juniors and 1:8 for Seniors are observed.
4. Qualifications:
 - a. All delegates must be registered Girl Scouts as of June, 2016.
 - b. Must be physically fit.
 - c. Must submit the consent paper signed by parent/guardian.
5. Aside from the GSP registration fee, a local registration fee of P10.00 for Junior and Senior Scouts, P20.00 for troop leaders and P20.00 for assistant troop leaders will be collected to cover the cost of activity materials and other incidental expenses.
6. Prizes will be given to the winners of the following contests:
 - a. Tent-Making (Junior and Senior)
 - b. Laro ng Lahi (Junior and Senior)
 - c. Cultural Presentation (Junior and Senior)
 - d. Cooking Contest (Senior)

7. Things to bring: *For individual:* GSP uniforms (optional), toiletries and other personal belongings, personal medicines, sleeping garments/bedrolls, flashlights, writing materials, jogging pants, one candle for Escoda Ceremony. *For patrol:* cooking utensils, eating utensils, food containers for food, water container for water storage, complete patrol gadgets, sleeping gadgets must be off-the-ground, extension wire/ electric bulb, plastic bags for waste segregation, materials for laro ng lahi and breakfast hunting.
8. Attached to this memorandum is the indicative program of activities during the encampment.
