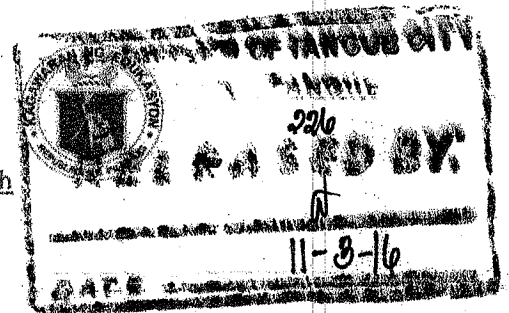

**Subject:** 2016 REGIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE (RSPC)

**Date:** November 24, 2016

1. Pursuant to Republic Act No. 7079, otherwise known as Campus Journalism Act of 1991, Department of Education, Region X through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), will conduct the **2016 Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC)** on November 8 – 10, 2016 in Bukidnon State University and Bukidnon National High School, Division of Malaybalay City with the theme "Strengthening Freedom of Information Through Campus Journalism".
2. The conference aims to achieve the following objectives:
  - a. Demonstrate understanding on the importance of journalism by expressing it through different journalistic endeavors and approaches;
  - b. Sustain advocacy on social consciousness;
  - c. Provide a venue for an enriching learning experience for learners interested in pursuing journalism as a career;
  - d. Promote responsible journalism and fair ethical use of social media; and
  - e. Enhance journalistic competence through healthy and friendly competition.
3. Participants are the Education Program Supervisors in English and Filipino, Chief of the CID, Division RSPC Working Committee Members, Top Three Winners of the Division Schools Press Conference (DSPC) contest for the Radio Broadcasting and Collaborative Publishing Contests in which only the top Group per level category is qualified to join as well as the Groups in TV Broadcasting per category in the secondary level.
4. A registration fee of One Thousand Pesos (P 1,000.00) for each participant shall be charged to School Education Funds (SEF) of the Division to defray the expenses on board and lodging, 6 meals and other contest materials while transportation expenses (back and forth including barge) in the amount of One Thousand and Twenty – Five Pesos (Php.1,025.00) which will be collected on Nov. 2, 2016 for final booking of the bus, daily allowances including meals & snacks not included in the registration, membership fees (60.00/coach & 30.00/journalist) and RSPC T- shirt of participants shall be charged to School Publication Funds and School MOOE or any other source of funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
5. Participating schools shall strictly follow the "No 20 – page School Paper, No student contestant" policy. Expenses shall be charged to School Publication Funds and School MOOE or any other source of funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures. School Heads of the participating schools are expected to give 100% support to their School Paper Organization to ensure submission of the required number of copies of the school publication as a requirement for participation.
6. Advisers, coaches and division journalism coordinators are responsible of the contestants' safety and security all throughout the RSPC thus, parents' permit, medical certificates and Registration Form/Participant's Profile must be prepared and submitted to the registration committee of the host schools division.
7. Delegates' assembly area is Tangub City Division Plaza and will leave at exactly 5:00 o'clock in the morning of November 7, 2016 and expected to be back on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2016.
8. Different Committees are created to ensure a safe, systematic and organize RSPC 2016 travel and participation. (Please see Enclosure No. 1)
9. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is enjoined.
