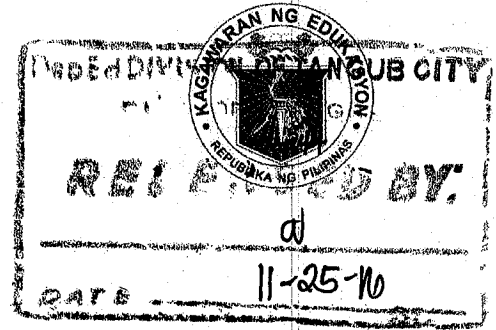

SUBJECT: DIVISION ORIENTATION-TRAINING WORKSHOP OF MULTIGRADE TEACHERS

1. The Department of Education through the Bureau of Elementary Education is strengthening the Implementation of Multigrade Program in the Philippines. It has been proven that multigrade classes given appropriate interventions, and their teachers provided with materials and appropriate training on effective teaching approaches can perform well in accordance to standards.
2. With this, the Division will conduct 4 day live-in orientation-training workshop for Multigrade Teachers on the Utilization of Budget of Work (BOW) and Leveled Readers on December 6 - 9, 2016 at Golden D Inn, Ozamiz City.
3. The Division Orientation-Training aims to:
 - a. enhance knowledge and skills on the utilization of BOW and Leveled Readers;
 - b. develop lesson plan /DLL based on Budget of Work (BOW);
 - c. formulate and produce formative assessment; and
 - d. develop an instructional materials that enhance the reading skills of the learners.
4. The training costs, which cover meals and snacks, lodging, supplies and materials, shall be charged to MG Funds. While travelling expenses of participants will be charged to school funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.

Cluster heads/ school Administrators of the multigrade schools are requested to join the training on the fourth day December. 9, 2016.
