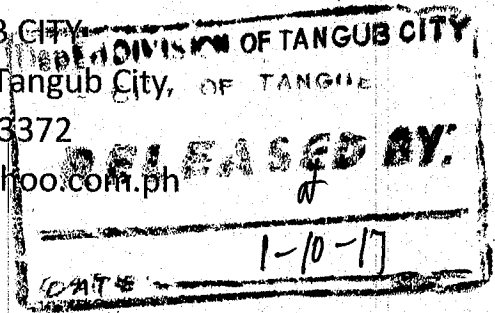

SUBJECT : **Division Search for Best Implementers of the Gulayan sa Paaralan Program  
in Public Elementary and Secondary Schools**

DATE : January 10, 2017

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 354 s. 2017 , entitled "Strengthening the Implementation of "Gulayan sa Paaralan Program in Public Elementary and Secondary Schools Nationwide ", this office announces the conduct of the Division Search for the Best Implementers School of Gulayan sa Paaralan Program (GPP ) on February 9-10, 2017 for the school year 2017.
2. Each school shall have a minimum of 200 square meter, however, for schools without available space/ flooded area, they can adopt container garden.
3. Recommended vegetables to be planted in the school garden are vegetable plants that can help address malnutrition problems in schools. These include (sources of protein) leguminous plants such as beans, mungo, peas, etc.; ( sources of calorie/energy ) rootcrops such as gabi, camote,cassava, ubi, etc. and ( sources of vitamin A and iron) leafy vegetables such as camote tops, malunggay, tops of gabi, saluyot, alugbati, kangkong, sili. patchay, kulitis, etc.
4. School garden products shall be primarily used to support the feeding program of the school.
5. All harvested vegetables shall be properly recorded by the school GPP coordinator with pictures before and during with the pupils/ students and teachers. This will be reflected in the record book the total number of kilos of vegetable harvested, number of kilos of harvested vegetables which are used in the school based feeding program and the number of kilos that are sold to pupils /students, teachers and community.
6. The board of judges in each district shall be composed of coordinating principal and two school heads from the district. Only the top three (3) schools will be declared as winners. Submission of the results will be on February 13, 2017. The Division evaluation will be on February 15,2017 with the Division EPS.
7. The board of judges for the secondary level shall be composed of three Division EPS . The evaluation will be on February 13, 2017.
8. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is required.
