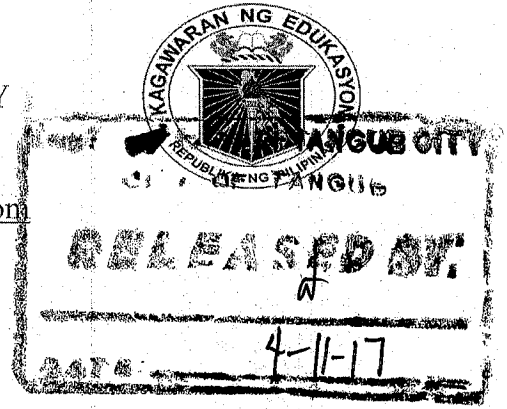

Subject : DIVISION SEARCH for TOP THREE BEST HONOR PUPILS' ADDRESSES in ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS and TOP THREE BEST HONOR STUDENTS' ADDRESSES in SECONDARY SCHOOLS

Date : March 11, 2017

1. To recognize the potentials and learning abilities of Grade 6 top honor graduates and Grade 10 top honor completers in this Division, a search for top three Best Honor Pupils' Addresses/Speeches and top three Best Honor Completers' Addresses/Speeches will be scheduled on April 26, 2017 at the City Function Hall I.
2. This search is now on its 6th year of implementation in the Division as part of the Tangub REWARDS program through the initiative and sponsorship of the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Tangub City.
3. Top three (3) winners in every District during the first round contest conducted in the closing program in the elementary schools and Grade 10 top honor completers in high schools are the qualifiers in the Division level Search.
4. The honor pupils' and honor completers' speeches/addresses shall be based on this year's graduation theme "Sabay-sabay na Hakbang Tungo sa Maunlad na Kinabukasan".
5. Attached are the contest guidelines/criteria for the search.
6. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

Contest Guidelines:

1. The search is open to all Grade 6 top honor graduates who are winners in the District level first round Search and Grade 10 top honor completers in high schools for the SY 2016-2017.
2. The masterpiece should be delivered in English and shall depict the theme of this year's Graduation Rites/Closing Exercises **"Sabay-sabay na Hakbang Tungo sa Maunlad na Kinabukasan"**.
3. The time limit for delivery should be a minimum of three (3) minutes and a maximum of five (5) minutes only. A one-point deduction shall be given for every minute excess of time.
4. During the division level competition, only top three (3) winners in the elementary and top three winners in the secondary shall be awarded.
5. It is a must that all Division level qualifiers shall submit three (3) hard copies of their contest piece to be placed in long folders at the Division Office three days before the conduct of the Division contest. Non-compliance on this particular guideline will mean disqualification from joining the actual Division level contest.
6. On the contest day, the judges will review and pre-judge the written speeches of the contestants prior to the actual oral contest.
7. During the actual delivery, the contestants (top honor graduates) will be rated based on the following criteria:

Masterpiece Relevant to the Theme	30%
Organization of Speech (coherence, emphasis and unity of ideas)	30%
Voice Quality and Enunciation	20%
Delivery (Confidence, Convincing, Stage Presence)	<u>20%</u>
Total	100%

8. The decision of the Search Committee is final and irrevocable.
