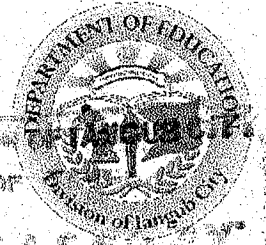

Subject: Division Training-Workshop in Campus Journalism for School Paper Advisers and Identified Journalism Coaches

Date: May 17, 2017

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act No. 7079 entitled "An Act Providing for the Development and Promotion of Campus Journalism", this Office shall conduct a training-workshop in campus journalism.
2. The three-day training for teachers-journalists is scheduled on May 29-31, 2017 and it will be done at the City Function Hall I.
3. Expected participants are the school paper advisers and identified journalism coaches from the elementary and secondary schools especially those who are collecting school publication fees.
4. Participants are advised to bring the following: laptop with charger and extension wire, digital camera, usb, conference notebook, ballpen and pen.
5. Attached is the distribution and summary of participants by school/district.
6. Meals and snacks will be provided to the participants charged to Division MOOE while transportation expenses of the participants shall be charged to school MOOE/local funds/school publication funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. There will be a registration fee of Three Hundred Pesos (P300) of each participant to defray expenses like honorarium for the invited resource persons and other materials needed in the whole duration of the training.
8. Wide and immediate dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned is expected.
